

Marine Aces of the South Pacific



Using the parallel stories of the two top-scoring US Marine Corps fighter aces of all time, this new book explores USMC aviation over the South Pacific.


America's Few delves into the history of US Marine Corps aviation in World War II, following the feats of the Corps' top-scoring aces in the skies over Guadalcanal. During the interwar period, the support of USMC amphibious operations became a key element of Marine aviation doctrine, and the small force gradually grew. It was over Guadalcanal that Joe Foss emerged as a symbol of Marine aviation. As commander of VMF-121, he organized a group of fighter pilots that downed 72 enemy aircraft; Foss himself reached a score of 26. Gregory 'Pappy' Boyington, meanwhile, had become a Marine aviator in 1935. Best known as the commander of VMF-214, he came into his own in late 1943 and eventually matched Foss's aerial victory score. Through the parallel stories of these two top-scoring fighter aces, as well as many other Marine aces, *America's Few* examines the development of US Marine Corps aviation in the South Pacific.

Bill Yenne is the author of more than 40 books and is the recipient of the Air Force Association's Gill Robb Wilson Award for the 'most outstanding contribution in the field of arts and letters [as an] author whose works have shaped how thousands of Americans understand and appreciate airpower.'



The Kriegsmarine in World War II




Hamstrung at first by the terms of the Treaty of Versailles, the German Navy, under Hitler, underwent a programme of rearmament in defiance of these restrictions, building modern warships under limitations which forced technological innovation. Following years of covert development, submarines became one of the Kriegsmarine's most deadly weapons and surface ships went on to play a crucial role in the opening salvos of World War II during the invasions of Poland and Norway. This highly illustrated volume is a comprehensive study of the German Navy throughout the war, from pocket battleships to torpedo boats.

Gordon Williamson, born in 1951, is a retired civil servant with a passion for military history. He spent seven years with the Royal Military Police (TA) and has written over 60 military titles including a number of Osprey World War II books. Amongst his primary interests are the German Navy in World War II, in particular the U-boats, and Military Police forces of both the Allied and Axis armies.



Panzer III

Thomas Anderson

This highly illustrated title details the history of the Panzer III from its early development through its pivotal role in the Blitzkrieg campaigns.


The Panzer III was the mainstay of the German armoured forces in the early years of World War II and spearheaded the victories in Poland, Western Europe and the Balkans. Later versions proved to be particularly effective during the campaigns in the Balkans and against British armour in the North African desert campaign. However, in the first months of Operation *Barbarossa* – the German invasion of the Soviet Union – it became obvious to battlefield commanders that the Panzer III had become obsolete as a main battle tank and it began to be replaced by the Panzer IV. The Panzer III was relegated to a secondary role, but its chassis proved the basis for the *Sturmgeschütz III*, which became the most widespread German armoured vehicle of World War II.

Thomas Anderson is a specialist on German armoured fighting vehicles of World War II, and his other titles for Osprey include *Panzer IV* and *Sturmgeschütz*. He regularly contributes to popular modelling and historical magazines, including *Military Modelcraft International* (UK), *Steel Art* (Italy), *Historia Militar* (Spain) and *Batailles & Blindés* (France). He lives in Germany.






The accepted historical narrative of World War II predominantly assigns U-boats to the so-called 'Battle of the Atlantic'. This has become an almost accepted error. U-boats were active in nearly every theatre of operation in which the Wehrmacht served, and within all but the Southern Ocean. Moreover, these deployments were not undertaken in isolation from one another; instead they were frequently interconnected in what became an increasingly inefficient German naval strategy. This fascinating new book places each theatre of action in which U-boats were deployed into the broader context of World War II in its entirety while also studying the interdependence of the various geographic deployments.

Lawrence 'Larry' Paterson is a musician, a scuba diver and a globally published author. He spent a period of time as a member of the Royal Navy Submarine Museum Archive Working group, specializing in U-boat records. His interest in World War II, and particularly the German forces, dates back to his childhood and he attributes much of his interest to both grandfathers – one who was an ANZAC during World War I and the other who was a Royal Navy stoker during World War II.



August 1945



August 15, 1945 officially marked the end of World War II, but conflict continued throughout the month. This title explores those final eventful weeks.


In the 44 months between December 1941 and August 1945, the Pacific Theater absorbed the attention of the American nation and military longer than any other. The stunning announcements of atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki on August 6 and 9 seemed sure to force Japan over the tipping point since the Allies' surrender demand from Potsdam, Germany, in July. What few understood was the vast gap in the cultural ethos of East and West at that time. In fact, most of the Japanese cabinet refused to surrender and vicious dogfights were still waged in the skies above Japan. This fascinating new history tells the dramatic story of the final weeks of the war, detailing the last brutal battles on air, land and sea with evocative first-hand accounts from pilots and sailors caught up in these extraordinary events.

Barrett Tillman is an award-winning author and speaker based in Arizona with more than 40 non-fiction books as well as novels to his credit. Tillman has appeared in more than a dozen documentaries including The History Channel's *Dogfights*. The son of a World War II aviator, he learned to fly at a young age and has logged hundreds of hours in historic aircraft.






Z Special Unit, one of the most intrepid but arguably the most unsung of Allied Special Forces of World War II, waged a guerrilla war against Japan for two years in the south-west Pacific. On some of their 81 operations Z Special Unit slipped into enemy harbours in canoes and silently mined ships before vanishing into the night; on others they parachuted into the dense Borneo jungle to fight with headhunters against the Japanese and on one occasion they landed on an Indonesian island and smuggled out the pro-Allied sultan from under Japanese noses. Drawing on veteran interviews as well as operational reports and recently declassified SOE files, Gavin Mortimer explores the incredible history of this remarkable Special Forces unit and the band of commandoes that defied the odds.

Gavin Mortimer is an award-winning writer whose books have been published on both sides of the Atlantic. Gavin has previously written for a wide range of newspapers and magazines. In addition, he has lectured on the SAS in World War II at the National Army Museum. He was also the historical consultant on the 2017 BBC documentary about the SAS.







The US Air Force over Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia, 1961–75



This vivid narrative history tells the full story of the US Air Force's involvement in the wars in the air over Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia.


The involvement of the US Air Force in the Southeast Asian Wars began in 1962 with crews sent to train Vietnamese pilots and finally ended in 1972 with the B-52 bombing of Hanoi, though there were Air Force pilots unofficially flying combat in Laos until 1975. The missions flown by USAF aircrews during those years in Southeast Asia differed widely, from attacking the Ho Chi Minh Trail at night with modified T-28 trainers, to missions 'Downtown', the name aircrew gave Hanoi. This aerial war was dominated by the major air operations against the north: *Rolling Thunder* from 1965 to 1968, and then *Linebacker I* and *II* in 1972, with the latter seeing the deployment of America's fearsome B-52 bombers against Hanoi. Featuring a wide range of personal accounts and previously untold stories, this fascinating history brings together the full story of the US Air Force's struggle in the skies over Southeast Asia.

Thomas McKelvey Cleaver has been a published writer for the past 40 years including his best-selling *The Frozen Chosen*, *Pacific Thunder* and *MiG Alley*. Tom is a veteran of the war in Vietnam and served with the US Navy's Seventh Fleet.



The Rangers at Pointe-du-Hoc, D-Day 1944



Written by one of the world's leading D-Day experts, this is a groundbreaking new history of the legendary Rangers' attack on Pointe-du-Hoc.


The Ranger attack on the German gun batteries at Pointe-du-Hoc in the early morning hours of D-Day is the stuff of legend. The gun batteries were strategically positioned between the two American D-Day landing beaches, and were considered the main threat to the Operation *Neptune* landings. In spite of the confusion and chaos of the June 6, 1944 mission, the Rangers succeeded in scaling the 100-foot cliffs, but the guns were nowhere to be found. Spreading out in all directions, a Ranger team managed to find and spike the guns at their hidden location south of Pointe-du-Hoc. For two days, this small force fought off repeated German attacks, until an American relief force finally arrived on 8 June. This new book takes a fresh and comprehensive look at the attack on Pointe-du-Hoc, examining the creation of the German gun battery, the initial Allied intelligence assessments of the threat, and the early plans to assault the site.

Steven J. Zaloga received his BA in History from Union College and his MA from Columbia University. He has worked as an analyst in the aerospace industry for over three decades. He is the author of numerous books on military technology and military history, with an accent on the US Army in World War II.

The Battle of Crécy in 1346 is one of the most famous and widely studied military engagements in history. The repercussions of this battle – in which England's King Edward III decisively defeated a far larger French army – were felt for hundreds of years, and the exploits of those fighting reached the status of legend. Yet groundbreaking research has shown that nearly everything that has been written about this dramatic event may be wrong. In this new study, Michael Livingston reveals how modern scholars have used archived manuscripts, satellite technologies and traditional fieldwork to help unlock what was arguably the battle's greatest secret: the location of the now quiet fields where so many thousands died. *Crécy* is a new history of one of the most important battles of the Middle Ages.



The German Battle of the Bulge



Based on new research, *Hitler's Winter* tells the story of the Battle of the Bulge from the German perspective.


The Battle of the Bulge was the last major German offensive in the West. Launched in the depths of winter to neutralize the overwhelming Allied air superiority, three German armies attacked through the Ardennes, the weakest part of the American lines, with the aim of splitting the Allied armies and seizing the vital port of Antwerp within a week. It was a tall order, and the desperate battle became a race against time and the elements, which the Germans would eventually lose. This new study of the famous battle focuses on the German experience, telling the story from the perspective of the German infantrymen and Panzer crewmen fighting on the ground in the Ardennes, through to the senior commanders such as SS-Oberstgruppenführer Josef 'Sepp' Dietrich and General Hasso von Manteuffel whose operational decisions did so much to decide the fate of the offensive.

Anthony Tucker-Jones started his career writing for *Jane's Defence Weekly* and *Jane's Intelligence Review*. He has written a number of books on aspects of World War II, including *The Devil's Bridge* and *Churchill, Master and Commander* for Osprey, and regularly appears on television and radio.



Air Warfare in the Cold War



From acclaimed aviation historian Michael Napier, this is a highly illustrated survey of the aerial fighting in the flashpoints of the Cold War.

The Cold War years were a period of unprecedented peace in Europe, but they also saw a number of localised but nonetheless very intense conflicts in which air power played a vital role. The postwar years saw a revolution in aviation technology and design, particularly in the fields of missile development and electronic warfare, and these conflicts saw some of the most modern technology of the NATO and Warsaw Pact forces deployed, alongside some relatively obscure aircraft types such as the Westland Wyvern and the Folland Gnat. *Flashpoints* describes eight of these Cold War conflicts: the Suez Crisis of 1956, the Congo Crisis of 1960–63, the India-Pakistan Wars of 1965 and 1971, the Arab-Israeli Wars of 1967 and 1973, the Falklands War of 1982 and the Iran-Iraq War of 1980–88.

Michael Napier is an experienced author with several published titles to his name, including *Korean Air War: Sabres, MiGs and Meteors, 1950–53*, *In Cold War Skies: NATO and Soviet Air Power, 1949–89* and *The Royal Air Force: A Centenary of Operations* published by Osprey. He is also an ex-RAF Tornado pilot with combat experience over Iraq.



Arguably one of the finest piston-engined fighters ever built, the Focke-Wulf Fw 190D-9 raised the bar in terms of aircraft design and operational capability during World War II. Designed by Kurt Tank, the 'long-nosed' Fw 190D-9 'Dora' bettered most of the fighters that the Allied and Soviet air forces could field when it first appeared in the skies over the Western and Eastern Fronts in 1944. Indeed, with experienced German pilots at the controls it proved to be an immediate match for even the later-mark Griffon Spitfire and the P-51D/K. Well-armed, with two 13mm machine guns and two 20mm cannon, the D-9 became part of Luftwaffe units from August 1944. Later on in the war, one of the key missions of the D-9 was to provide top cover for Me 262 jet fighters when at their most vulnerable during take-off and landing.



Luftwaffe Reichsmarschall Hermann Göring admitted that the appearance of long-range Mustangs over Berlin spelled the end of the Jagdwaaffe's ability to defeat American daylight bombing. But the Mustang was far more than an escort – it was a deadly hunter that could out-perform nearly every German fighter when it was introduced into combat. Entering the war in Europe in December 1943, P-51Bs and P-51Cs had advantages over German Bf 109s and Fw 190s in respect to the altitude they could reach, their rate of climb and top speed. Initially tapped for close bomber escort, Mustangs were quickly turned loose to range ahead of the bomber stream in order to challenge German fighters before they could assemble to engage the bombers en masse.
